

DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal 2023

Effective: 31.12.2022 – Changes are printed in *italics*

Only the German text of the regulations “**DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal**” will be binding.

The DMSB announces the „**DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal**“ (Status: National A) according to Level 4 of the general DMSB-Prädikatsbestimmungen.

The Pokal (Cup) is based on the currently valid version of:

- the FIA International Sporting Code including the Appendices,
- the FIM/FIM-E International Sporting Code,
- the DMSB-Reglements für Drag Racing (Drag Racing Rules),
- the DMSB-Veranstaltungsreglement (Event Rules),
- the DMSB-Lizenzbestimmungen (License Regulations),
- the general and specific DMSB-Prädikatsbestimmungen (Predicate Regulations),
- the DMSB-Umweltrichtlinien (environmental guidelines),
- the Doping Regulations of WADA/NADA,
- the DMSB and FIA-Anti-Doping-Regulations or rather FIM-Anti-Doping-Code and – any other regulations/guidelines of FIA or rather FIM/FIM-E and DMSB.

Art. 1 Participation Requirements

DMSB-Deutscher Drag Racing Pokal

Drivers who are in possession of a national license level B or higher from the DMSB or any other ASN affiliated with the FIA are entitled to participate and receive points for the DMSB Drag Racing Pokal.

Drivers who are in possession of a National DMSB-License Level C or Racecard or equivalent from any other ASN affiliated with the FIA are entitled to participate in the individual events according to local licence regulations, but do not receive any points for the DMSB Drag Racing Pokal.

dmsj-Deutscher-Junior-Drag-Racing-Pokal

Children and youngsters between the ages of 8 and 18 (effective date: birthday) who have at least a National License Level C (incl. Racecard) or a higher licence from the DMSB or any other ASN affiliated with the FIA/FIM/FIM-E are eligible to compete and collect points in the DMSB Junior Drag Racing Pokal. Foreign drivers need the start permit to compete abroad from their own ASN (National Sport Authority), some licences include the start permit on the license, for information please contact your ASN.

Art. 2 Race classes

Only the following classes according to DMSB, FIA and/or FIM/FIM-E regulations are included and eligible for points:

Pro ET	(9.00 – 11.99 Sek.)
Super Gas	(Index 9.90 Sek.)
Sportsman ET	(12.00 – 13.99 Sek.)

E.T. Bike	(9.00 Sek. und langsamer)
Super Comp Bike	(Index 8.50 Sek.)

Art 3. Registration

(1) Registration must be done using the registration form issued by the promoter DMV - Deutscher Motorsport Verband e.V. which is provided on the promotor's homepage: www.dm-dragracing.de.

(2) Registration deadline is ~~31.03.2023~~ **extended to 30.04.2023**

Art. 4 Race dates

The race dates will be announced on the promoter's homepage www.dm-dragracing.de.

Art. 5 Points system

(1) All results of the event dates will be counted. There is no deletion result.

(2) Points for the individual race classes are awarded as follows:

Qualifying points:

1 point per qualifying position, maximum of 16 points. If there are more than 16 participants in qualifying, 1 qualifying point will be awarded from 17th position, according to the following table:

Round points:

20 Points are awarded for each round win.

If a race is called off, the round points in a class will only be awarded to the round winners if all pairings of the round in this class have been completed. Otherwise, the points are awarded up to the last complete run of the class.

Art. 6 Awarding points

- (1) The official evaluation of the results (flowcharts) and the allocation of points is carried out by the promoter. In cases of obvious error, the promoter can change the allocation of points even after publication.*
- (2) If an organizer creates a result that does not correspond to the general DMSB-Prädikatsbestimmungen (predicate regulations) and/or these predicate regulations, the promoter reserves the right to change the result lists accordingly and to allocate points according to the DMSB regulations. No appeal is possible against the decision.*
- (3) A minimum of three (3) vehicles must have participated in a class for points to be awarded.*
- (4) If an alternate* is inserted after the qualification results and the elimination ladder have been posted and due to de-registration/no-show, the alternate driver will receive the points according to the table above. The driver that was originally qualified will receive his/her qualification points.*
- (5) All points and rankings are published on the promoters (DMV) homepage: www.dm-dragracing.de. Objections must be submitted to the promoter in writing by October 15th, 2023 to sportabteilung@dmv-motorsport.de.*

**Alternate = driver moving up from the qualifying list or first of the non-qualified drivers or second, etc.*

Art. 7 Even points

Should numerous drivers have the same number of points within in a class in the final results, the following criteria applies in the order given and is decisive on the award of the title:

- a) Driver with the most event wins*
- b) Driver with the most round wins*
- c) Driver with the most events*

All cases of even points will be decided by the DMSB or promoter.

Art. 8 Title

The driver with the most points in Super Pro ET will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal Super Pro ET 2023“

The driver with the most points in Super Comp will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal Super Comp 2023“

The driver with the most points in Pro ET will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal Pro ET 2023“

The driver with the most points in Super Gas will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal Super Gas 2023“

The driver with the most points in Sportsman ET will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal Sportsman ET 2023“

The driver with the most points in ET Bike will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal ET Bike 2023“

The driver with the most points in Super Comp Bike will be awarded the title:

„Winner DMSB-Drag-Racing-Pokal Super Comp Bike 2023“

The driver with the most points in Junior Dragster will be awarded the title:

**„Winner dmsj-Deutscher-Junioren-Drag-Racing-Pokal
Junior Dragster 2023“**

The driver with the most points in Junior Drag Bike will be awarded the title:

**„Winner dmsj-Deutscher-Junioren-Drag-Racing-Pokal

Art. 9 Awards ceremony

- (1) The award ceremony will take place as part of the DMV Gala of Champions. The respective class winner as well as the Runner-up and third place winner will be invited to the award ceremony in writing.*
- (2) Trophies will only be presented as part of the award ceremony; no trophies will be kept, sent or handed over at a later date.*
- (3) The promoter reserves the right to move the award ceremony to another date and/or place.*

Art. 10 Interpretation of the predicate provisions

- (1) The interpretation of these provisions is reserved for the DMSB or its sports jurisdiction.*
