

II. SPECIFIC CAR/BIKE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

5. dmsj – *Deutscher* Junior-Drag-Racing-Pokal 2026

Changes are printed in *italics*.

The following articles apply to the „dmsj – *Deutscher* Junior-Drag-Racing-Pokal 2026“. The German version is binding. The Promoter is DMV e.V.

Art. 1 – PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Children and youngsters between the ages of 8 and 18 (effective date: *year of* birthday) for Junior Dragster *and 8 to 18 (effective date: year of birthday)* for Junior Drag Bike who have at least a national license level C (Race Card incl.) or a higher license from the DMSB or any other ASN affiliated with the FIA/FIM/FIM-E are eligible to compete and collect points in the dmsj Junior Drag Racing Pokal. Foreign drivers will need a start permit to compete abroad from their own ASN (national Sport Authority), some licenses include the start permit on the license, for information please contact your ASN.

Art. 2 – DATES

The race dates will be announced on the promoter's homepage www.dm-dragracing.de.

Art. 3 – RACE CLASSES

Only the following classes according to DMSB, FIA and/or FIM/FIM-E regulations are included and eligible to collect points:

Cars: Junior Dragster (*incl. Junior Funny Car and Junior Roadster*)
Bikes: Drag Bike

Art. 4 – REGISTRATION

- (1) Registration must be done using the registration form *issued by the promoter DMV – Deutscher Motorsport Verband e.V.* which is provided on the promoter's homepage www.dm-dragracing.de.
- (2) *Registration is a onetime process. The closing date for registration is no later than 24 hours before one of the events announced by the promoter. Only races taking place after registration will be eligible for points.*
- (3) *There is no fee for registration.*

Art. 5 – POINTS SYSTEM

- (1) The results of all events announced by the promoter count. There is no *scratch* result.
- (2) Points are awarded for each individual race class as follows:

Qualifying points:

One (1) point per qualifying position, maximum of sixteen (16) points. If there are more than sixteen (16) participants in qualifying then one (1) qualifying point will be awarded from the seventeenth (17th) position, according to the following table:

Round points:

If a race is called off, the round points in a class will only be awarded to the round winners if all pairings of the round in this class have been completed. Otherwise, the points are awarded up to the last completed round of the class.

All remaining participants (not qualified, no-shows in round 1) will receive **10 points**.

Art. – 6 RESULTS / CALCULATION OF POINTS

- (1) The official evaluation of the results (flowcharts) and the allocation of points is carried out by the promoter. In cases of obvious errors, the promoter can change the allocation of points even after publication.
- (2) If an organizer creates a result that does not correspond to the DMSB-Prädikatsbestimmungen (general predicate regulations) and/or these predicate regulations, the promoter reserves the right to change the results accordingly and to allocate points according to the DMSB regulations. No appeal is possible against the decision.
- (3) *At least four (4) participants must be registered in the class, for a participant to be eligible for points. The decisive factor here is the number of registered drivers at the time of the last event of the series.*
- (4) A minimum of *four (4) vehicles* must have participated in *qualifying of the respective* class, to be eligible for points.
- (5) If an alternate* is inserted after the qualification results and the elimination ladder have been posted and due to de-registration/no-show, the alternate driver will receive the points according to the table above. The driver that was originally qualified will receive his qualification points.
- (6) All points and rankings are published on the promoter's (DMV) homepage www.dm-dragracing.de. Any objections must be submitted to the promoter in writing by *October 15th, 2026* to dragrace@dmv-motorsport.de.
- (7) *In the event of a rain-out, the participants who won the round before the rain-out will be awarded the points for the next round, provided the round before the rain-out was completed.*

(8) *An appeal against points awarded (or not awarded) must be lodged within seven days of the first publication of the points in dispute in writing to dragrace@dmv-motorsport.de.*

**Alternate = driver moving up from the qualifying list or first of the non-qualified drivers or second, etc.*

Art. 7 – TIE BREAKERS

Should numerous drivers have the same number of points within a class in the final results, the following criteria applies in the order given and is decisive on the award of the title:

- a) Driver with the most event wins
- b) Driver with the most round wins
- c) Driver with the most events

All cases of even points will be decided by the promoter.

Art. 8 – TITLE

The driver with the most points in Junior Dragster will be awarded the title:

„dmsj – Deutscher Junior-Dragster-Pokal-Sieger 2026“

The driver with the most points in Junior Dragster will be awarded the title:

„dmsj – Deutscher Junior-Drag-Bike-Pokal-Sieger 2026“

Art. 9 Awards Ceremony

- (1) *The award ceremony will take place as part of the DMV Gala of Champions on November 23rd, 2024. The respective class winner as well as the Runner-up and third place winner will be invited to the award ceremony in writing.*
- (2) *Trophies will only be presented as part of the award ceremony; no trophies will be kept, sent or handed over at a later date.*
- (3) *The promoter reserves the right to move the award ceremony to another date and/or place.*

Art. 10 Interpretation of the predicate provisions

- (1) *The interpretation of these provisions is reserved for the DMSB or its sports jurisdiction.*
