THE ROAD TO THE WORLD CUP

A global pathway. One ultimate destination.

The FIA Karting Arrive & Drive World Cup is the final chapter of a new global competition pathway, built around continental qualifying events in Europe, Asia-Pacific and South America.

Across the season, drivers compete in designated regional competitions where seats for the World Cup are awarded based on sporting performance. The best talents from each region earn their place on the grid for a single, decisive World Cup event.

The Competition

Three days. One chance.

Each competition is run over one intense 3-day event:

- Free Practice
- Sprint Race
- 3 Qualifying Heats per driver
- Final Phase:
 - A-Final (Top 28 after heats)
 - B-Final (remaining drivers)

Categories & Eligibility

Pure talent. Equal equipment. No shortcuts.

- **Junior:**
Drivers born 2012–2014, International Karting Licence Grade G
- **Senior:**
Drivers born 2008–2012, International Karting Licence Grade E or F

To ensure fair access, drivers must not have competed in any FIA Karting Championship or Cup in 2024–2026 (FIA Karting Academy Trophy participation is permitted).

For drivers under 18, the competitor must be a parent or legal guardian holding a valid International Competitor Licence. No ASN nomination is required to register.



Identical Arrive & Drive Package

All drivers compete with strictly identical equipment, supplied and managed by the organiser:

- Kosmic chassis
- Vortex SV Junior / SV engines (centrifugal clutch)
- Vega Option slick tyres
- Fuel, trolley and paddock tent included

Drivers bring their own CIK-homologated personal equipment (gloves, shoes, helmet), basic tools and a mechanic.

Only rain tyres, if needed, are to be purchased separately.

WHO CAN RACE?

- Max. 56 drivers per category and competition.
- You need an international licence, G for Junior and E or F for the Senior category, issued by your ASN.
- You need FIA homologated equipment (incl. rib protector, shoes and gloves).
- Priority is given to the licence holder of the respective continent on which the championship is held.
